



Personal social and emotional development

WK 1 - Kidsafe session - Feelings - what makes us sad, scared. Worried and happy.

WK 2 - Look at the term push ourselves- what does this mean? What does this look like? Talk about targets that we have shared with our

WK 3 - Children talk about their own behaviour – how we should behave in different situations

WK 4 - How certain behaviours are unacceptable - which types of behaviours are not acceptable in school or at home and why. What should we do if they see someone acting a certain way etc.

WK 5 - Discuss with the children how we behave when we are out of school. Talk to the children about representing our school, listening carefully, following the rules and being careful – link to Lifeboat visit.

WK 6 - Children show confidence to meet and talk to others (police/firefighters/ambulance)
